



Kevin Cullinane appointed JCI (Junior Chamber International) General Legal Counsel 2003.

Kevin Cullinane is the 2003 General Legal Counsel of JCI (Junior Chamber International) the worldwide federation of young leaders and entrepreneurs. JCI has over 200,000 members between the ages of 18 and 40 and millions of alumni in over 100 countries worldwide.

Cullinane, nominated by Junior Chamber Ireland, has previously served two terms as a member of the JCI Board of Directors: in 2001, as Vice President assigned to the national organisations of Canada and the United States; and in 2002 he was elected Executive Vice President and assigned to Europe where he chaired the JCI European Conference in Istanbul, Turkey last June.

JCI's mission is "To contribute to the advancement of the global community by providing the opportunity for young people to develop the leadership skills, social responsibility, fellowship and entrepreneurship necessary to create positive change."

Cullinane is employed as Murphy's Irish Stout Marketing Manager with Heineken Ireland in Cork. He holds a bachelor's degree in Business Studies (Marketing) from the University of Limerick.

Since joining JCI in Dun Laoghaire in 1989, Cullinane has participated in various local, national, and international activities, serving as President of JCI Dun Laoghaire in 1992, National President of JC Ireland in 1997, JCI European Secretary/Treasurer in 1999, and Parliamentarian to the JCI European Conferences in 1999, 2000 and 2001. He is currently a member of JC Cobh.

He has attended over 20 international JCI Conferences and Congresses and received honorary life membership of JCI in 1996.
